Congratulations to Miss Chapman who had a beautiful baby boy in the Summer holidays. We can't wait to meet him.

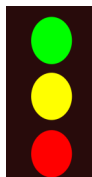
ASSEMBLIES

Class Assemblies - These will take place on Thursdays at 10.10 am. Please come to the main school entrance if you wish to attend your child's class assembly.

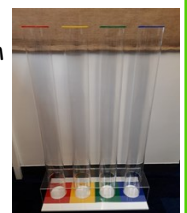

POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT - TEAM POINTS
