

This half term our topic is

**The Wonderful
World of Roald Dahl**



Why the Wonderful World of Roald Dahl?

To encourage the children to read interesting and exciting books that engage them and develop their imaginations and curiosity with stories that really excite them. When children find stories they love, it gives them the confidence and motivation to try more challenging books. "If we can raise children with an intrinsic love of reading, it leads to an indelible desire to learn," says Jonathan Douglas from the National Literacy Trust.

As readers and writers we will be...

Reading a variety of stories by Roald Dahl and then use these stories as a basis for our own story writing. We will also be reading and writing our own poems linked to chocolate.

As mathematicians we will be...

We will be adding and subtracting numbers with up to 3 digits. We will be counting in multiples of 4, 8, 50 and 100. The children will be recalling and using multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.

As scientists we will be...

Identifying that humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition and that they cannot make their own food; they get nutrition from what they eat. We will also identify that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection and movement.

To develop our understanding of religion we will be...

Learning about what Christians do at home, in church and in the wider community and why these things are important to them.

To bring our topic to life we will be...

Visiting York Chocolate story and learning about the history of chocolate and making our own chocolate bar.

As explorers we will be...

Finding out about the life of Roald Dahl and Quentin Blake. We will be learning about how chocolate is made and exploring the environments where cocoa beans and sugar grow. We will also look at the transportation of these products around the world.

As creative learners we will be...

Looking at the illustrations / artwork of Sir Quentin Blake. We will also be creating portraits of Roald Dahl characters, in the style of Sir Quentin Blake.

As computer technicians we will be...

Designing and writing a program that accomplishes a specific goal. We will also learn to use repetition commands and debugging. We will introduce variables and If statements.

As sports people we will be...

Learning the rules and skills involved in Basketball. In gymnastics we will be linking movements together to create sequences and identifying the muscle groups used in gymnastics.
