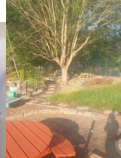
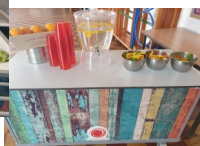


**School Photographer** The school photographer will be in school on Wednesday 15th September. The children will have individual and siblings in school photos.
