Due to the recent tragedies across the Wakefield District, please may I share this information from West Yorkshire Police, to reinforce the dangers of open water. Please do not be tempted to enter the water or allow your children to do so. Cold water can shock the body into closing down, there is also the risk of drowning.

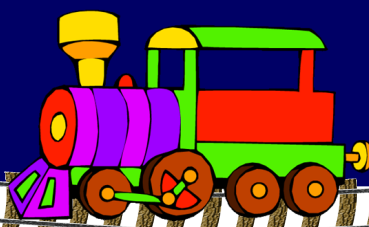
