Hendal Primary Scho Belong, Aspire, Achieve. Maths - As mathematicians, we will begin to identify notes and coins. We will be learning to solve problems with money.

We will be learning the two, five and ten times-table and using this knowledge to solve multiplication and division facts. This will help us to achieve in Diamond Dash.

Science Enquiry:

We will be learning about properties of a range of materials and exploring how they can change their shape.

Working Scientifically:

We will be using simple equipment to carry out our own investigations.

Computing - As Computer Technicians we will be using Purple Mash and the 2 Simple Software to create our own art work using different art styles and effects.

PE - As sports people we will be beginning to develop the skills needed for sports that involve hitting, catching and running. We will also be learning new techniques in gymnastics.

Art and Design - As Artists we will be learning about the work of Barbara Hepworth. We will be taking part in a paper sculpture workshop and clay modelling workshop to create sculptures, just like Barbara Hepworth.

History - As Historians we will learn about the life of Barbara Hepworth and Henry Moore and understand why they are remembered today. **Design and Technology** - As designers, we will be beginning to look at toy vehicles.
