# Why is our World Wonderful?



**Maths:** As mathematicians we will be learning methods to solve multiplication and division calculations. We will also be learning about measurements including length and height and mass, capacity and temperature.

Science: We will be learning all about living things and their habitats to find out how animals are suited to their surroundings. Science Investigation: Do animal babies look the same when they become adults?

Art and Design: Children will be completing their work on Barbara Hepworth and creating an abstract clay sculpture. Children will evaluate their finished sculpture.

This term children will also be creating products to take home for Mother's Day and Easter.

**Geography:** As geographers we will be learning about the world we live in.

We will be using Google Earth and atlases to locate continents, oceans and famous landmarks around the world.

We will also be creating maps of our local area and exploring our school grounds on a mini-beast hunt.

**Design and Technology:** As designers we will be investigating toy vehicles and designing our own vehicle, thinking about the user and purpose.

**Music**: As musicians we will be working in groups to compose and perform in the topic "Dynamics, tempo and motifs."

**Computing:** As Computer Technicians we will be using Purple Mash to make our own music.
