NHS Healthy Lunch Boxes Policy

The NHS have are a few suggestions for Healthy Lunch Boxes. Children should eat at least one portion of fruit and one portion of vegetables e.g. carrot sticks, cucumber, small apple or orange, banana, dried fruit, mini tomatoes. Meat, fish or other source of non-dairy protein e.g. chicken, turkey, ham, beef, pork, tuna, lentils, kidney beans, chickpeas. A starchy food e.g. bread, pasta or rice, crackers, rice cakes, oat cakes, pitta bread, tortilla wraps. Dairy food e.g. milk, cheese, yoghurt or fromage frais. A drink of water, fruit juice, milk, yoghurt drink or smoothie.

Our alternative suggestions to snacks such as crisps include;

- Savoury crackers or breadsticks served with a dip.
- Vegetables and fruit.
- Low sugar cereal bars. sugar free jellies with fruit.
- Cakes and biscuits in moderation.

Can we remind parents that NO EGGS (e.g. Egg Mayonnaise, quiche etc), NUTS or nut products (including Nutella and chocolate spread) are allowed in school as we have children with severe allergies.
