English:

We will be reading a range of books this half term which link to our Marvellous Me theme. Some examples include: The Lion Inside, Super Duper You, We Are All Different, My Five Senses.

Phonics: We will be starting our Floppy's Phonics scheme to learn the letter sounds, 's, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k' We will also be learning the tricky words, 'l, to, the'

Marvellous Me

What makes me marvellous?

Maths: We will be following the Mastering Number scheme. This half term we will be subitising (recognising how many without counting) up to 3 objects and sounds. Use the language more than and fewer than.

JIGSAW: Children will be learning through the topic Being Me in My World. They will learn to help others feel welcome, think about everyone's right to learn, care about other people's feelings and work well with others.

Expressive Arts and Design: In our creative development we will paint, collage, cut, stick, build, sculpt and draw. We will create a self-portrait and build on them weekly. This will include sketching, mixing our skin tone, collaging, using the fringing technique and finally using different media to add on our features.

Understanding the World: We will be learning all about the season of Autumn and the changes that happen. Children will participate in an Autumn walk after making vegetable soup and bread. We will be learning about our bodies and how we grow from babies to adults. After learning about ourselves we will explore the larger concept of My Wakefield and features of where we live.

Communication and Language:

Children will listen carefully to a range of stories. They will understand and practise asking *what* questions. Children will develop their vocabulary linked to our *Marvellous Me* theme including the words *special, unique, similar* and *different*. There will be a focus on vocabulary linked to family and our local area.

Computing: We will be using Google Earth to look at our local community and where we live. We will be using the iPads to take photographs of Autumnal objects on our Autumn Walk.

PE: As sports people we will be learning to use our balance bikes safely.
